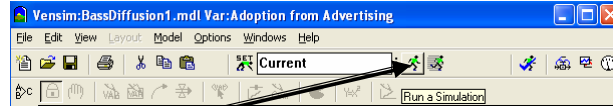


## Vensim Tips

(1)

### □ To Run Model



- Click
- or Model >> Simulate or Control-R

### □ To compare results from multiple runs,

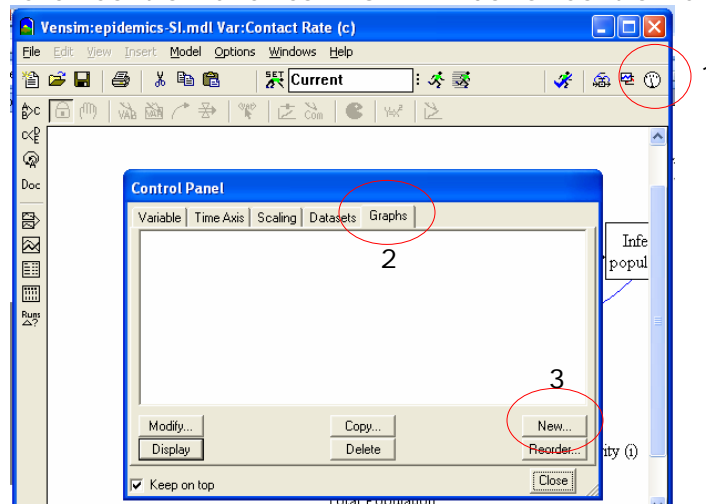
- Save each run DataSet in separate files
- Select NO for "Dataset Current already exists. Do you want to overwrite it?"
  - Give a new file name instead
  - Each combination can be saved in separate DataSets

## Vensim Tips

(2)

### □ Plot multiple variables together in a single chart

- Click Control Panel icon –OR- Windows > Control Panel



## Vensim Tips

(3)

- Click *control panel* > *Graph tab* > *New*
  - Give *TITLE*
  - Enter/ select *Variables*
